The AEL is looking to appoint a lecturer to teach Conservation Ecology and related modules for the Higher Certificate in Conservation Ecology programme (NQF 5) at its Uizip Campus. The ideal candidate will have a background in Zoology, be a well organised individual who is passionate about teaching and the youth and who can function well within a diverse team.

Overarching Job Description:

The incumbent will report to the Head of the Academic Programme and will be responsible for the delivery of selected modules, which involves:

- Presentation of lectures and practicums;
- Conducting assessments;
- Continuously developing and updating module content and applying quality control;
- Doing academic administration; and
- Participating in extra-curricular activities and academic tours.

In addition, the incumbent will be involved in a broader sense to assist the AEL in reaching its organisational goals, *inter alia* by:

- Liaising with role players in nature conservation and related industries and participating in community projects for social impact;
- Conducting and publish research, and co-supervise postgraduate students in collaboration with colleagues and other research institutions;
- · Assisting with the presentation of short courses; and
- Acting as professional environmental consultant for EcoDriven.
